

DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED ALONG WITH THE APPLICATION

- Original Birth Certificates for candidates from Nursery (Hiradale) to Std. I
- One latest passport size photo of the candidate.
- A copy of the unmasked E-Aadhar card of the student and both the parents.
- For Hiranandani Flat Owner Agreement Copy (Index Page And Address Page)
 Latest Maintenance Bill (If Society Is Formed)
- Electricity Bill in case of Non-Flat Owner.
- Proof of Sibling wherever applicable A copy of the ID card
- Std. II to Std. IX should submit the original leaving certificate of the candidate before June 09, 2025, which is mandatory. Admission will be formally confirmed upon receipt of the original leaving certificate.

The Leaving certificate should have a mention of the following –

- The school UDISE No., PEN No. and students' SARAL ID No. (only for students coming from Maharashtra)
- Aadhar card no. of the student
- Promotion to the next class
- No requests for admissions will be entertained by the School Management or the School Office.
- Recommendation / request letters regarding admission will amount to rejection of the application. Kindly do not meet the school authorities regarding such matters.
- The School and its Management do not accept any donations or capitation fees. Beware of those who promise admission in exchange for money or other favours.
- Admission to Std. V and above is contingent upon a mandatory entrance test and interview.
 Selection will be based on performance in both the test and interview and is subject to availability of seats in each class.
- A new pupil who has attended a recognized school cannot be admitted without a Leaving Certificate from the school last attended.
- In the case of children in the Pre-primary Section, should the government enforce any age
 restriction different to the one currently prevailing in the school, parents would have to comply
 with the regulation.
- Registration does not guarantee admission.

WITHDRAWALS

- A written notice of withdrawal must be given three months in advance. In special cases such as sudden transfer of parents, the Principal reduce the period of notice. Students leaving school in November and after will be charged all fees till the end of May.
- The Caution Money will be refunded provided all dues are paid, library books or any other property which the student may have taken are returned to school in a proper condition. Also note Caution money will be released after we receive confirmation of admission from your child's new school.
- The Leaving Certificate will be given free of charge if the application is made within one year from the date of leaving the school or from the date of the result of public examination for which the pupil sat. After this period, a search fee of Rs. 100/- will be charged. Two weeks' time must be given for the Leaving Certificate to be issued.
- The Principal reserves the right to request the withdrawal of any student if his/her behaviour is found unsatisfactory.







CURRICULUMHIRADALE, PRE-PRIMARY:

The Pre-Primary Section of the HFS has a preschool programme that is divided into Hiradale, JR. KG and SR. KG. catering to the needs of children in the range of 3- to 5-year-olds.

It functions on the principle of learning by doing it through the play-way method. We guide the child to step into the world of learning in an environment outside the comfort zone i.e. their home.

During this stage we focus on developing social, emotional, cognitive, and physical skills in a safe and supportive atmosphere through various activities such as Indoor free play, clay modelling, Outdoor free play, Music session, Art and Craft, Educational field trip, Picnic.

We also facilitate promoting our children's personal growth and development. Our babies are encouraged to express themselves with the help of singing, dancing, Show and Tell, storytelling, Fancy dress festival celebrations and Projects to enhance their communication skills and shed their stage fright. The children get to showcase their hidden talents during the Annual Concert and test their motor skills during Sports day. Special activities such as Sprouts bhelpuri day and Truffle fruit pudding are organized during the academic year to enlighten their minds on healthy eating habits. A Day in the kitchen puts their culinary skills to test, where they are guided to make a simple yet mouth-watering recipe.

During the formative years in Pre-primary, we train the tender minds to develop their logical, imaginative, organizational, and interpersonal skills. Structured learning is facilitated with the help of academics and the Smart board, interspersed with games, to enhance the learning outcome among the children which will last a lifetime. A child's mind is full of curiosity, wonder and emotions. Values are taught through lucid short, effective stories and Puppet shows. Puppets are a good tool to get young children's attention and help them to act out everyday scenarios.

Grandparents' day is celebrated with great fervour and delight where our beloved grandparents are invited to spend a day with our babies. The children are trained to present a short entertainment programme and later they are encouraged to participate in fun-filled activities and lots of dancing and singing, to take home cherished memories for a lifetime.







CURRICULUM

ICSE [Std I -X]:

- The school year begins in June and terminates in April.
- The school prepares students for the Indian Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ICSE).
- Regular attendance is a requirement of the Council.
- Candidates are declared successful if they reach a prescribed minimum aggregate of marks in the compulsory subjects while at least attaining a credit in three subjects, which must include the subject English and the pass standard in three subjects.
- They must also pass in SUPW (Socially Useful and Productive Work) with a minimum of a 'C' grade.
- Hindi and Marathi languages are taught from Std. I
- Art, Craft, Value-based Education, Music, Physical Education, SUPW and Swimming also form a
 part of the curriculum.
- There are four Houses in the school ALPHA, BETA, DELTA and SIGMA
- The sports steered by the PE department are Football, Basketball, Throw ball, Hand ball, Volleyball, Cricket, Gymnastics, Athletics, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho and Carrom. Inter-House Matches and competitions are held in all these games.
- HFS offers after school coaching in Football, Basketball, Swimming, Table-Tennis, Skating, Taekwondo, Chess and cricket. These activities are conducted in the school premises from 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Inter-House Competitions in General Knowledge, Elocution, Carrom, Chess, Table Tennis, Swimming, Music, Dance, Debates, Impromptu Speech, Handwriting, and Essay Writing are also held.
- The school has the Interact Club and Eco Club. The Interact Club aims at fostering a sense of social concern and international understanding among young students by insisting on constructive leadership, recognition and thoughtfulness for others and awareness of the importance of home and family. It undertakes various relief projects on behalf of the underprivileged.
- The HFS Eco Club empowers students to participate and take up meaningful environmental activities and projects. This forum helps to promote environmental awareness amongst the parents and neighborhood communities.
