

# Students from Thane win medals at 16th ASISC national aquatic c'ship

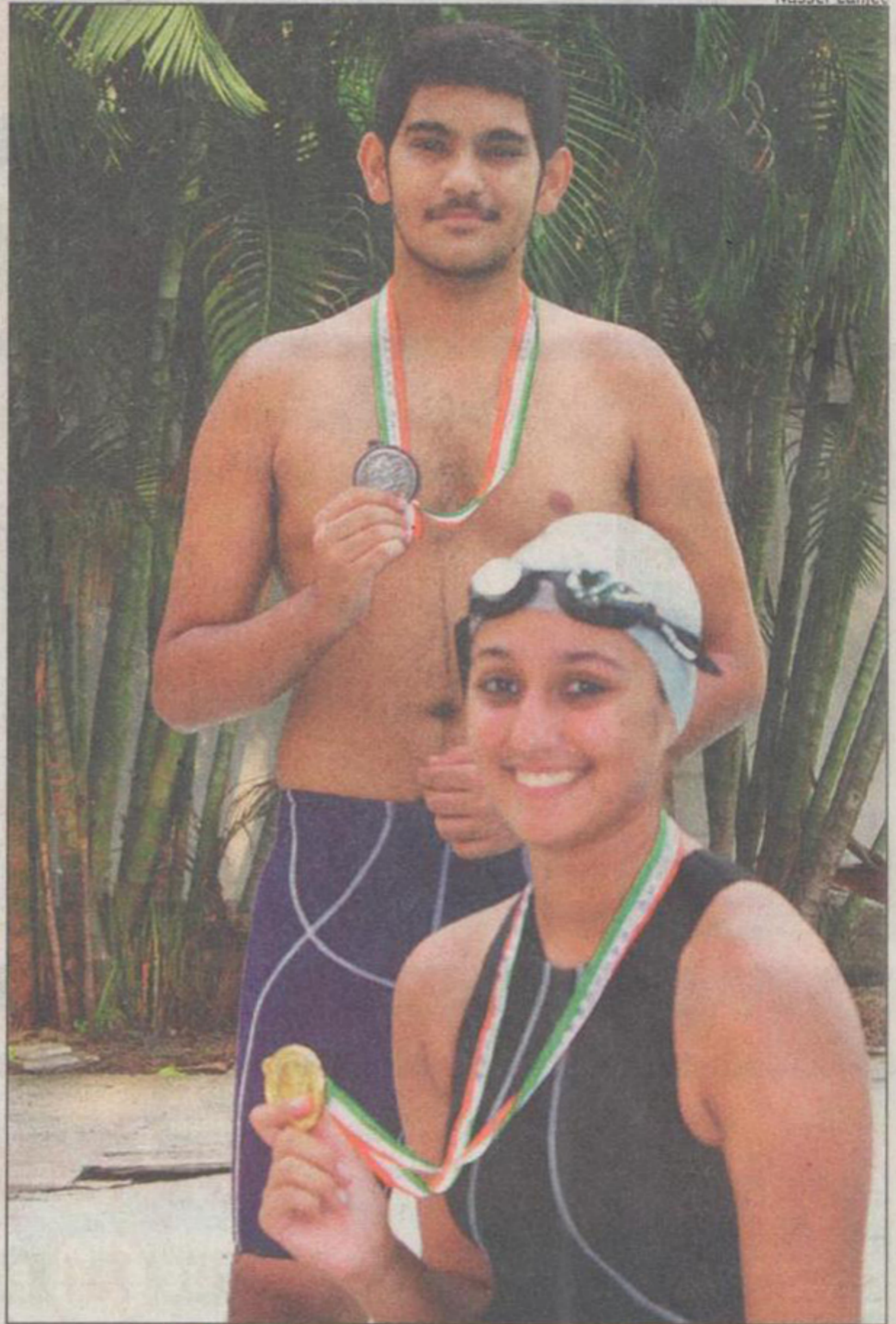
Anandita Chouhan and Gitanshu Bhatia of Hiranandani Foundation School, Thane were proud medal winners at the 16th ASISC National Aquatic Championship.

Anandita, a key member of the Maharashtra 4x100 mtrs freestyle relay team helped her team bag the gold medal with a timing of 4.46 minutes and Gitanshu secured the third place in 50 mtrs backstroke with a timing of 35.24 seconds.

The championship was held under the aegis of ASISC (Association of Schools for the Indian School Certificate) at Valsad, Gujarat recently. Both Anandita and Gitanshu were medal winners at the nationals last year too.

Earlier four students of the school were selected for the nationals at the 9th AISM (Association of ICSE/ISC Schools of Maharashtra) Aquatic Meet held on August 31 and September 1, 2012 at Goregaon. At the nationals, Tanya Chawda represented Maharashtra in 50mtrs butterfly, Sakshi Garg in 50 mtrs and 100 mtrs breaststroke and Gitanshu in 50 mtrs backstroke.

Anandita represented the state in 100 mtrs backstroke and was also selected for Maharashtra 4x100 mtrs Freestyle Relay team.
